KENYA DELUXE ITINERARY

May 24 Depart from North America

Our adventure begins as we board our flight to Europe!

May 25 Frankfurt

Overnight in Frankfurt
SHERATON HOTEL AIRPORT

May 26 Nairobi

Board our flight for Africa. Our Micato Safari Director will greet us upon arrival in Nairobi, the capital city in the heart of the Kenyan Highlands. Here we will have the evening to relax at the elegant FAIRMONT NORFOLK HOTEL.

May 27 Nairobi

B/L/D

A morning safari briefing and visits to the Karen Estate, Giraffe Center and the Elephant Orphanage. Then we are invited for lunch at LAVINGTON, the home of Felix and Jane Pinto, your Kenya Hosts and the proprietors of Micato Safaris and our longtime friends.

Evening accommodations are at the FAIRMONT NORFOLK HOTEL.

This morning, after breakfast, we fly to Amboseli National Park. Amboseli is known for its magnificent elephants – a population of over 1000 elephants reside in the park's eco-system, one that features some of the largest in Africa. We will then drive to the TORTILIS TENTED CAMP.

Tortilis Camp has a prime location for witnessing the majesty of Africa's highest mountain, Kilimanjaro. It is named after the flat-topped, umbrella thorn tree, the Acacia Tortilis. It embraces a hill in one of Amboseli's areas of Acacia Tortilis woodland and is located in a private conservancy bordering the national park.

Morning and afternoon game drive.

May 30 – June 1

AMBOSELI - LOISABA CONSERVANCY

After breakfast, we depart for the airstrip, and fly to Nairobi for our connecting flight to LOISABA CONSERVANCY. We will be staying at LOISABA TENTED CAMP. The camp is perched on the edge of an escarpment. It is designed to take advantage of unhindered views across the Laikipia Plateau's breath-taking landscape, all the way to the peaks of Mount Kenya.

Loisaba Conservancy provides a safe haven for more than 260 species of birds and 50 species of mammals, including lions, wild dogs, reticulated giraffe, and the endangered Grevy's zebra. It also lies within an important movement corridor for the country's second-

largest population of elephants. Game drives, camel rides and a visit to Samburu Village included.

June 2 Maasai Mara

B/L/D

Morning flight from Loisaba to Nairobi and connect to a flight to the MAASAI MARA —

This is the Africa of your imagination, where panoramas are vast. It is a country of rolling grasslands, dense thickets of shrubs, and groves of Acacia Woodland, where predators might hide. A lush forest grows along the banks of the Mara River where hippos and crocodiles bask in the sun.

Arrive at the FAIRMONT MARA SAFARI CLUB, a luxury tented camp. Enjoy the atmosphere, which evokes fantasies of days gone by, when intrepid adventurers and hunters traveled these plains in search of big game. Upon arrival you will enjoy a delicious buffet lunch and time to relax. Later in the afternoon go on a game drive.

June 3 - 4 Maasai Mara National Reserve

B/L/D

Your day begins with a game run in the cool morning when the animals are most active. It is the best time to experience the full range of wildlife in the reserve. Or, if you prefer, there is a wonderful option of an early morning Balloon Safari. It is an exhilarating experience as you float only a few hundred feet above herds of wildlife for 60 glorious minutes. Afterwards, touch down for a champagne breakfast on the Mara Plains.

Morning and afternoon game drive each day and for the last night in Mara we enjoy dinner in the Bush.

The Mara has the largest population of lions in Kenya and Cap buffalo congregate in huge numbers. There is no way to predict what you might see on your drive today. Keep your eyes open!!

With diligence and luck, you may encounter a family of cheetahs or a herd of elephants crossing the path in front of you. Large animals crossing the path in front of you aren't the only entertainment. You may be amused by a family of warthogs running as fast as their little legs will carry them until they forget why they are rushing and stop to regroup.

June 5 Nairobi - Depart

B/D

After an early game drive and breakfast, we fly to Nairobi, and transfer to the BOMA HOTEL. A dayroom has been reserved for you there. The afternoon is for leisure, or shopping. After dinner, transfer to the airport for your flight home. You will bid farewell to Kenya knowing that this has been a journey you will remember for the rest of your life.
