

## Banff Tour #1

### **Tour Level is moderate for walking**

8:30 – We will leave from designated pick-up point at Moon Travel, #3  
– 3360 27 St, NE

Please have a photo ID with you and wear comfortable walking shoes and clothing, including some type of head covering.

9:30 – Stop for pit stop at Dead Man's Flats. Dead Man's Flats is a hamlet in Alberta within the Municipal District of Bighorn No. 8. Statistics Canada also recognizes it as a designated place under the name of Pigeon Mountain. It is located within Alberta's Rockies at Highway 1 exit 98, approximately 7 kilometres southeast of Canmore and 78 kilometres west of Calgary. We will use the restrooms and clients can check out the souvenirs.

10:00 – 10:30 – Arrive in Banff. Banff is a town within Banff National Park in Alberta, Canada. It is located in Alberta's Rockies along the Trans-Canada Highway, approximately 126 km west of Calgary and 58 km east of Lake Louise. At 1,400 to 1,630 m above sea level, Banff is the community with the second highest elevation in Alberta, after Lake Louise.

10:30 -11:00 – Museum. The Banff Park Museum National Historic Site, located in downtown Banff, Alberta, is an exhibition space associated with Banff National Park. The museum was established in 1895 to house an exhibit of taxidermy mounted specimens of animals, plants and minerals associated with the park. The museum building, constructed in 1903 to the design of territorial government engineer John Stocks, is an early example of the rustic style of architecture that was becoming popular in the parks of North America

12:00 – Lunch Stock Food & Drink at Banff Springs or similar. The Fairmont Banff Springs, formerly and commonly known as the Banff Springs Hotel, is a historic hotel located in Banff, Alberta, Canada. It was opened in 1888 and is of Scottish Baronial architecture. The entire town including the Hotel, is situated in Banff National Park, a national park managed by Parks Canada. The hotel overlooks a valley towards Mount Rundle, both of which are situated within the Rocky Mountain mountain range. The hotel is located at an altitude of 1,414 metres.

1:00 – Walk-about downtown (souvenirs) One of the major attractions of downtown Banff is the fantastic shopping that can be found along Banff Ave., Bear St. and all of the side streets and malls in between. Souvenir hunters have a wide selection of gift shops to choose from, and fashion lovers will be impressed by the range of clothing stores. Banff shopping options also include a good variety of jewellers, outdoor stores, ski shops, and don't forget to visit one of the candy stores for home made chocolate, fudge and ice cream.

3:30 – Meet at designated pick-up  
Head count to begin trip back to Calgary

5:30 – Arrive in Calgary at designated spot.
